The Principles of Church Discipline

- 1. It's patterned after God's love.
- 2. It accomplishes three things.
 - A. It guards and preserves God's honor.
 - B. It protects the purity of the church and guards others from being harmed.
 - C. It rescues wayward Christians from God's discipline.
- 3. God views failure to discipline as prideful, hateful, and unloving.

2 Corinthians 2:5-8 But if any has caused sorrow, he has caused sorrow not to me, but in some degree—in order not to say too much—to all of you.6 Sufficient for such a one is this punishment which was inflicted by the majority,7 so that on the contrary you should rather forgive and comfort him, lest somehow such a one be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow.8 Wherefore I urge you to reaffirm your love for him.
