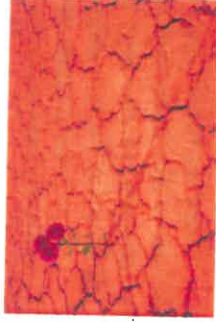

- Paul's \_\_\_\_\_ to Timothy (vv1-2)
  - Who's involved
    - Paul
    - Timothy (Acts 16:1-3; I Tim. 1:3)

**I Cor. 4:17**— For this reason I have sent to you Timothy, who is my beloved and faithful child in the Lord, and he will remind you of my ways which are in Christ, just as I teach everywhere in every church.

**I Thess. 3:2**— and we sent Timothy, our brother and God's fellow worker in the gospel of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you as to your faith,

**Blanks:** Greeting, Reminder, faith, Challenge, legacy, faithfulness, boldly

**Philp. 2:19-22** – <sup>19</sup>But I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, so that I also may be encouraged when I learn of your condition. <sup>20</sup>For I have no one else of kindred spirit who will genuinely be concerned for your welfare. <sup>21</sup>For they all seek after their own interests, not those of Christ Jesus. <sup>22</sup>But you know of his proven worth, that he served with me in the furtherance of the gospel like a child *serving* his father.

- God the Father & Christ Jesus

- “Grace, mercy, and peace”

- Paul’s \_\_\_\_\_ to Timothy (vv3-5)

- Paul points Timothy to the one, true \_\_\_\_\_ to which we are called. (Eph. 4:4-6; II Tim. 4:7)

**Eph. 4:4-6** – <sup>4</sup>There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling; <sup>5</sup>one Lord, one faith, one baptism, <sup>6</sup>one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.

**II Tim. 4:7** – I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith;

- Paul’s \_\_\_\_\_ to Timothy (vv6-7)

- Timothy needs to rekindle his gift!

- The Spirit God gave us does not produce δειλία [deílial] (fear in the sense of cowardice or a lack of mental or moral strength).

- Rather, he gave us a Spirit of σύναιμα, ἀγάπη, and σωφρονομία [sōphrōnismōs] (a sound mind or discipline; in this context, means the ability to do what you know is right).

**I Cor. 16:13-14** – <sup>13</sup>Be on the alert, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong. <sup>14</sup>Let all that you do be done in love.
