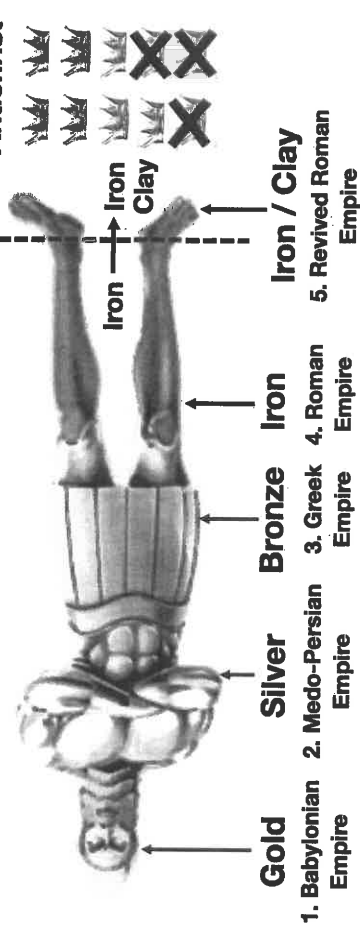

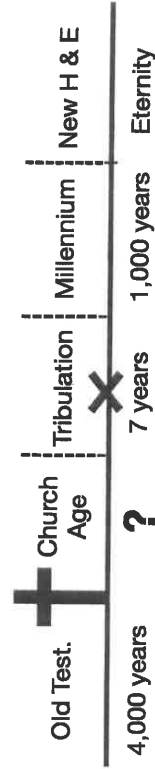

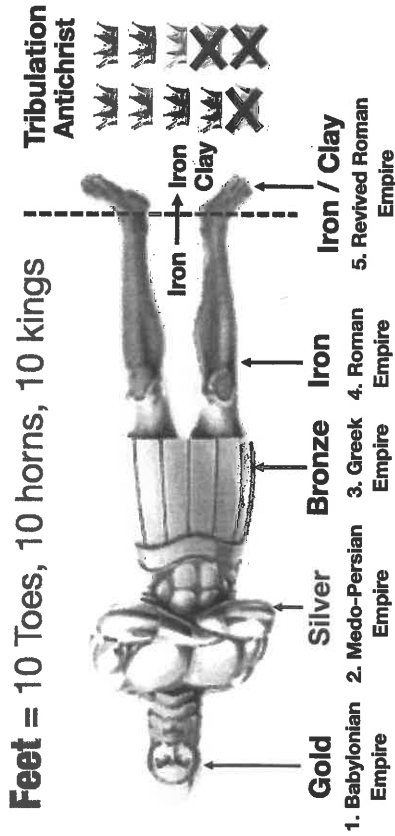


43 "And in that you saw the iron mixed with common clay, they will combine with one another in the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, even as iron does not combine with pottery."

44 "In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever."

45 "Inasmuch as you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands and that it crushed the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold, the great God has made known to the king what will take place in the future;

so the dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy."

2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no one in any way deceive you, for it will not come unless the apostasy comes first, and the **MAN** of lawlessness is revealed, the **SON OF DESTRUCTION**,

Same description is used for (Jn 17:12)

Will the Antichrist be a Jew or Gentile?

Daniel 11:37 "He will show no regard for the **GODS** of his fathers or for the desire of women, nor will he show regard for any other god; for he will magnify himself above them all.

KJV "Neither shall he regard the **GOD** of your fathers

"Gods" is plural in the Greek.

Most likely he will be a Gentile.

Daniel 7:7-8 "After this I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, dreadful and terrifying and extremely strong; and it had large iron teeth. It devoured and crushed and trampled down the remainder with its feet; and it was different from all the beasts that were before it, and it had ten horns. 8 "While I was contemplating the horns, behold, another horn, a little one, **CAME UP AMONG THEM**
Daniel 7:23-25 "Thus he said: "The fourth beast will be a fourth kingdom on the earth, which will be different from all the other kingdoms and will devour the whole earth and tread it down and crush it. 24 'As for the ten horns, out of this kingdom **TEN KINGS** (*Gentiles*) **WILL ARISE; AND ANOTHER WILL ARISE AFTER THEM.**

40 "Then there will be a **FOURTH KINGDOM**

This refers to - 4. Roman empire

as strong as iron; inasmuch as iron crushes and shatters all things, so, like iron that breaks in pieces, it will crush and break all these in pieces.

41 "In that you saw the feet and **TOES**, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, it will be a divided kingdom; but it will have in it the toughness of iron, inasmuch as you saw the iron mixed with common clay.

42 "As the **TOES** of the feet were partly of iron and partly of pottery, so some of the kingdom will be strong and part of it will be brittle.

What do the ten toes represent?

Daniel 7:24 'As for the **TEN** horns, out of this kingdom **TEN KINGS** will arise; and **ANOTHER will arise after them**, and he will be different from the previous ones and will subdue three kings.

But the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.

Daniel 2:44 "In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever.

36 "This was the dream; now we will tell its interpretation before the king. 37 "You, O king, are the king of kings, to whom the God of heaven has given the kingdom, the power, the strength and the glory; 38 and wherever the sons of men dwell, or the beasts of the field, or the birds of the sky, He has given them into your hand and has caused you to rule over them all. You are the head of gold.

39 "After you there will arise **ANOTHER KINGDOM** inferior to you,

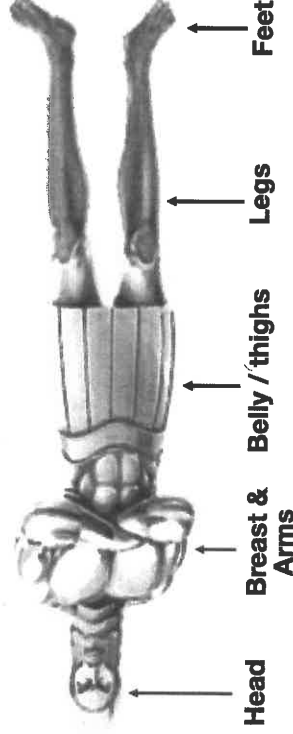
This refers to 2. Medo-Persian empire

then another **THIRD KINGDOM** of bronze, which will rule over all the earth.

This refers to - 3. Greek empire

Daniel 2: 31-43 "You, O king, were looking and behold, there was a single great statue; that statue, which was large and of extraordinary splendor, was standing in front of you, and its appearance was awesome.

32 "The head of that statue was made of fine gold, its breast and its arms of silver, its belly and its thighs of bronze, 33 its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay.

"head" - gold

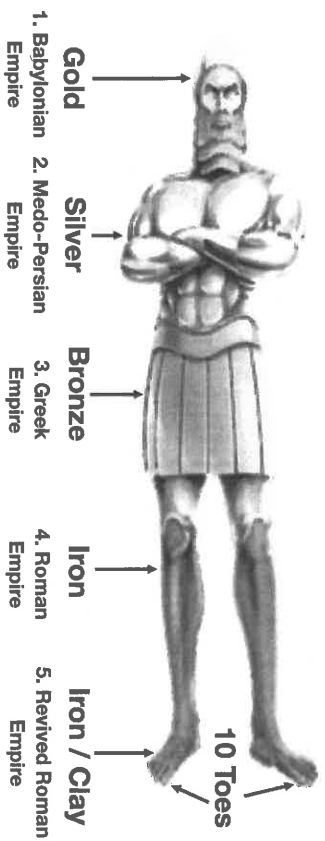
"chest and arms" - silver

"belly and thighs" - bronze

"legs" - iron

"feet" - iron / clay

Why the different metals?

1. Each kingdom decreases in value therefore, each becomes less valuable and less glorious.
2. As they progress they also increase in strength.
 - “gold” = 1. Babylonian Empire
 - “breast / arms” = 2. Medo-Persian Empire
 - “belly / thighs” = 3. Greek Empire
 - “legs” = 4. Roman Empire
 - “feet” = 5. Revived Roman Empire
