In the O.T.

Describes anytime God punishes evildoers.

They used it for their own time and also for predictions of judgment in the end times.

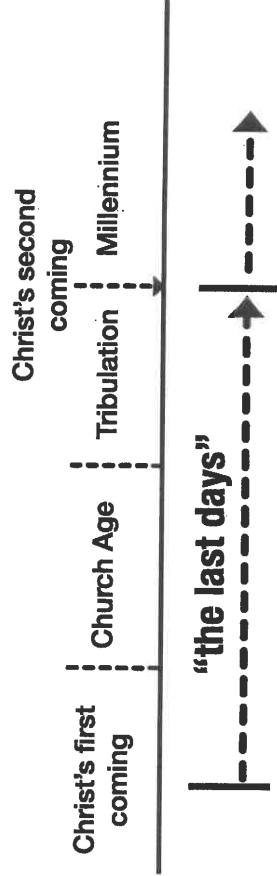
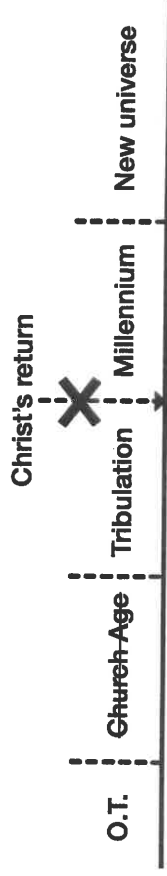
1. In the seven-year **tribulation** when God judges unbelieving Israel. - Thess. 5:2; 2 Thess. 2:2
2. It includes the **Lord's return** at the end of the Tribulation. - 2 Thess. 1:7-10
3. It includes the **Millennium** when Christ will rule the earth with a rod of iron. - Acts 2:20
4. It includes a **new universe** with the final destruction of the heavens / the earth

The pouring forth of God's Spirit will be accompanied by two supernatural signs.

1. It will be without distinction.

“Day of the Lord”



The “last days” began at the Lord’s first advent and will end when He returns to establish His kingdom on earth.

“Day of the Lord”

The Day of the Lord generally refers to any period when God acts in judgment

Citing verses from the Old Testament was a common practice.

There are 2,606 quotes in 7,967 verses.

_____ % of Acts has direct references from the O.T.

There are 231 quotes in 1,006 verses.

Two hermeneutic principles of interpretation we need to know.

Prophetic _____

The O.T. prophets saw the consummation of redemptive history as one singular event.

There are hints of two purpose for the Messiah’s coming.

1. His death to pay for sin.

Isaiah 53:4-5 Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted. 5 But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.

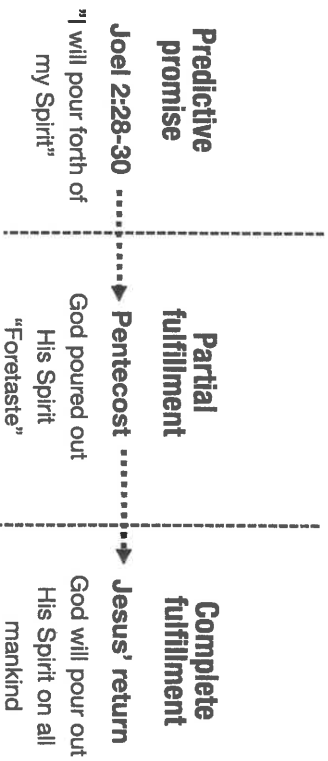
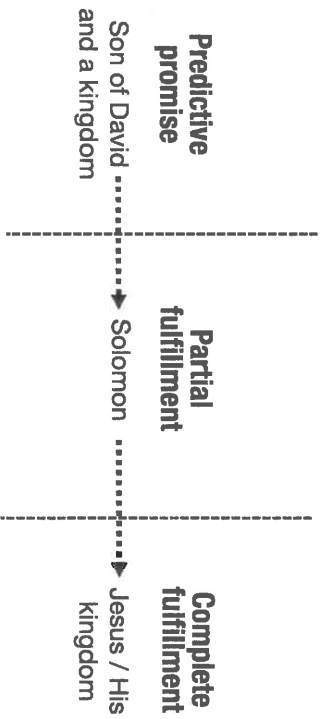
2. His reign and rule over His kingdom.

Isaiah 9:7 There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will accomplish this.
