
<u>Lesson</u>: 49. Zechariah, pt. 5 – Not by

## The Eight Visions of Zechariah's Second Prophecy

- 1. The Night Patrol: Israel's judgment is over, and God never forgot about them.
- 2. The Four Horns: Israel's tormentors will be judged.
- 3. The Measuring Line: Jerusalem will be rebuilt into a multiethnic capital where God will dwell among His people.
- 4. The Filthy Priest: God is the One Who sanctifies priests to represent Israel, but one day, an Ultimate Priest will come to represent ALL God's people.

Rev. 1:12–13, 20 – Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking with me.
