  - o The fasts are finally addressed, but not with a direct answer.
    - The fast of the fourth month commemorated when Jerusalem's walls were breached (cf. 2 Kings 25:3–4; Jer. 39:2; 52:6–7); the fast of the tenth month commemorates when the siege of Jerusalem began (cf. 2 Kings 25:1; Ezek. 24:1–2).
